

Terms and Conditions

1. The promoter is: The Rosey Project as a subsidiary of Glasgow and Clyde Rape Crisis whose registered office is at 4th Floor, 30 Bell Street, Glasgow, G1 1LG.
2. The competition is open to residents of Greater Glasgow and Clyde (*Glasgow, Renfrewshire, East Renfrewshire, East Dunbartonshire, West Dunbartonshire, Inverclyde*) aged 13-25 years except employees of Glasgow and Clyde Rape Crisis and their close relatives and anyone otherwise connected with the organisation or judging of the competition.
3. There is no entry fee and no purchase necessary to enter this competition.
4. By entering this competition, an entrant is indicating their agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions.

7. Closing date for entry will be 19th November 2018. After this date no further entries to the competition will be permitted.

Entries must fit within the principles and ethos of Glasgow and Clyde Rape Crisis and best practice sexual violence prevention messages. Entries must be submitted with the following details:

 - Area of residence (Glasgow, Renfrewshire, East Renfrewshire, East Dunbartonshire, West Dunbartonshire, Inverclyde)
 - Age category (13-15, 16-18, 19-21, 22-25)If these details are not provided with the entry, the promoter will request the information.
10. The promoter reserves the right to decide if entries fit within the principles and ethos of Glasgow and Clyde Rape Crisis and best practice sexual violence prevention. Entries found to not fit within these criteria will be disqualified.

11. Entries containing hate speech, pornography, violence, personal details or other inappropriate content will not be accepted.
12. Entries must be submitted by an individual. Entries will not be accepted from groups or organisations.
13. All entries must be original content created by the individual submitting the entry.
14. The promoter shall have the right, at its sole discretion and at any time, to change or modify these terms and conditions, such change shall be effective immediately upon posting to this webpage. Any changes to the competition will be notified to entrants as soon as possible by the promoter.
15. The promoter also reserves the right to cancel the competition if circumstances arise outside of its control.
16. The promoter is not responsible for inaccurate prize details supplied to any entrant by any third party connected with this competition.
